F.No. 3-1/2015/PR/GP.— Whereas, the total number of seats to be filled by direct election in each Gram Panchayat has been determined by the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman in respect of South Andaman District vide Order No. 3-12/Panch./D-Cell/2015/3359, dated 28th April, 2015;

Whereas, the total number of seats to be filled by direct election in each Gram Panchayat in the North and Middle Andaman District has been determined by the Deputy Commissioner, North and Middle Andaman, vide Order No. 4-204/DC(N&M A)/14/1491, dated 28th April, 2015;

Whereas, the total number of seats to be filled by direct election in each Gram Panchayat in the Nicobar District has been determined by the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District, vide Order No. 1-8/DCN/Note/2015/65, dated 28th April, 2015;

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant General (Retd.) Ajay Kumar Singh, Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, in pursuance of Sub-Section (8) of Section 11 read with Sub-Section (7) ibid of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) Regualtion, 1994 (No. 1 of 1994) and in supersession of the Administration's Notification No. 69/95, dated 3rd April, 1995 and subsequent Notifications on the subject, hereby determine the number of seats to be reserved for women in every Gram Panchayat, as detailed in the Schedule below:
