No.5-5/EC/A&N/2015 (A): Whereas, the proposals for delimitation for Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad constituencies in North & Middle Andaman District were published in the Official Gazette vide Notification No. 5-5/EC/A&N/2015 (A) dated 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2015, inviting suggestions and objections by 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 in compliance with rule 7 (1) & (2) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995.

And whereas, suggestions and objections received before the specified date were duly considered by the Election Commission appointed under section 185 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) Regulation, 1994;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 11(4), section 107(2) and section 145 (2) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) Regulation, 1994 read with rule 7 (2)(d) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995, the Election Commission for the Union Territory of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, after considering all the suggestions and objections received, hereby determines the delimitation of the Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad constituencies in the North & Middle Andaman District as detailed in Annex-II appended to this notification and publishes the same in the Official Gazette.

Detailed maps showing the extent of each constituency of each Gram Panchayat are included as Annex-III.

The suggestions and objections received in response to the Election Commission's proposals for delimitation of each constituency of Gram Panchayats, Panchayat Samitis and Zilla Parishad in the North & Middle Andaman district have been summarized and the Election Commission's order thereon is enclosed as Annex-I.

#### Final Order of Election Commission on delimitation of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad constituencies in the North & Middle Andaman District for the forthcoming election

Draft delimitation proposals in respect of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad constituencies in the North & Middle Andaman District were notified on 14.05.2015 by the Election Commission in exercise of powers under section 11 (3) & 11 (4), section 107 and section 145 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) Regulation, 1994 read with rule 7(1) & (2) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayat) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995. Suggestions and objections were invited upto 25.05.2015.

In all three objections/suggestions, one each from Diglipur, Mayabunder and Rangat Tehsils respectively, were received by the due date. These three objections and suggestions received have been duly considered by the Election Commission.

The Pradhan, Kalighat Gram Panchayat, Diglipur Tehsil had requested to exclude Nishchintpur Village from the Kalighat Gram Panchayat as this village already has road connectivity and electricity supply from the Nabagram village side. The Commission examined the objection/suggestion and found that the Nishchintpur village is adjacent to Kalighat village and the distance from the Nishchintpur village to Kalighat Gram Panchayat office is only 03 kms., while it is 07 kms. from the Nabagram Panchayat office. The objection of the Pradhan Kalighat Gram Panchayat was overruled as the people of the Nishchintpur village had themselves asked to be attached to Kalighat Gram Panchayat in view of the proximity to Kalighat village which made it easier to meet their daily requirements from the Kalighat bazaar area.

The Pradhan Gram Panchayat, Harinagar, Mayabunder Tehsil, had requested that an additional ward from Pinakinagar Ward No.1 & 2 be carved out, but that would require an additional seat. As determination of seats is not under the purview of the Election Commission, this objection/suggestion of Pradhan could not be considered by the Commission.

The Tehsildar, Rangat had informed that the names of constituencies of Uttara Gram Panchayat had erroneously been published in the draft proposal and this may be corrected. The Commission has accepted the suggestion and rectification has been made accordingly.

Consequent to this consultation, the Election Commission modified its notification of draft proposals for the delimitation of Gram Panchayat constituencies. The constituencies of Panchayat Samitis and Zilla Parishad in North & Middle Andaman published in the draft proposal remain unchanged. The Election Commission hereby orders the final delimitation of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad constituencies under North and Middle Andaman District as detailed in Annex-II.
